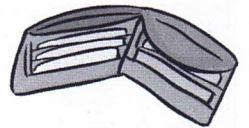








Assistant: Thank you very much, and have a nice day.


