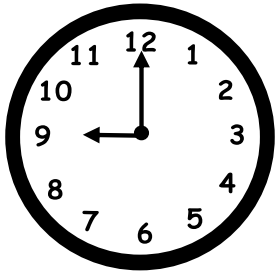
Red arrows indicate the following connections:

- 3:00 clock to "It's ten past five."

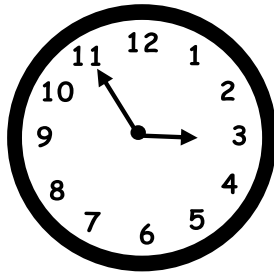
