When I (come) back home my family (eat) dinner. We always (eat) dinner together. Then we (talk) about our day and (play) games together. We sometimes (watch) TV too, but not very often. My dad (think) watching TV (be) silly.

Around seven o'clock I (go) into my room. There I (read) a book or (chat) with my friends on my phone. Then I (go) into the bathroom and (brush) my teeth. I sometimes (take) a hot bath too, but only in winter. After that, I (brush) my hair and (go) to sleep. I always (fall) asleep at nine o'clock.
