Present Tense

Merksatz:
He, She, It,
das **S** muss mit

Bildung

+ I speak English at school.
My brother plays tennis in the garden.

- I don't speak English at school.
My brother **doesn't** play tennis in the garden.

? Do I speak English at school?
Does my brother play tennis in the garden?

Verneinung mit
don't oder doesn't

Ja/Nein Fragen mit
do oder does

Wichtig!

Das Verb to be wird zu am, is, are

Einzahl	Mehrzahl
I am	We are
You are	You are
He/She/It is	They are

+ She **is** my best friend.

- Tom **isn't** at home.

? **Is** Lucy your sister?.

2. PRESENT PROGRESSIVE

The present progressive

Verlaufsform der Gegenwart

Wird verwendet, wenn wir über Dinge sprechen die gerade passieren oder über fixe Pläne für die Zukunft

Form of "to be" (am, is, are) + verb + **-ing**

positive +		
person + am/is/are + verb + -ing		
I	+ am	+ play ing
he/she/it	+ is	+ juggl ing
you/we/you/they	+ are	+ balanc ing
Example: She is juggl ing on the stand		



Signal words

Now, at the moment,
right now, look,...



negative -		
person + am/is/are not + verb + -ing		
I	+ am not	+ play ing
he/she/it	+ is not	+ juggl ing
you/we/you/they	+ are not	+ balanc ing
Example: She is not juggl ing on the stand		

question ?		
am/is/are + person + verb + -ing		
am	I	+ play ing
is	he/she/it	+ juggl ing
are	you/we/you/they	+ balanc ing
Example: Is she juggl ing on the stand?
