4. My **aunt** (Tante) Susan and my **uncle** (Onkel) Joe visit us every Sunday.
5. They show us **photos** (Fotos) of my **cousins** (Cousins/ Cousinen) and their **house** (Haus) in London. It looks so **big** (groß) and **nice/beautiful** (schön).
6. My **grandma/grandmother** (Großmutter) and my **grandpa/grandfather** (Großvater) live in Canada so they are not always here.
7. In the **kitchen** (Küche) there is my **dog** (Hund) Danny and my **cat** (Katze) Daisy.
